

## **MSDS Requirements for Protac, Inc Pressure Sensitive Products**

*Protac* has investigated how the OSHA HAZARD COMMUNICATION STANDARD (29CFR, Part 1910.1200) relates to the Protac Pressure Sensitive product line. This standard is designed to ensure that information concerning chemical hazards is transmitted to manufacturing employees. Employees must be advised of certain hazardous components in excess of 1% and carcinogens in excess of 0.1%. The OSHA standard defines “articles” as materials which do not release or otherwise result in exposure to hazardous chemicals under normal conditions of use. Articles are exempt from the Hazard Communications Standard.

*Protac’s* products are considered “articles”. The use of these products at ambient temperatures poses no health hazards when used as intended in product design. Material is not intended for use in burning applications.

Therefore, no Material Safety Data Sheet is required.
